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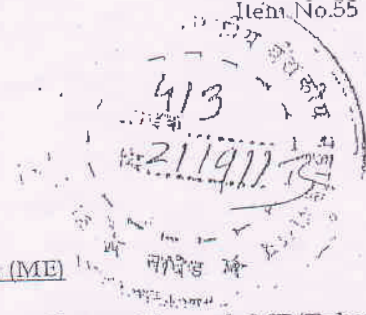

Sub: Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik - Recognition of MD(Tuberculosis & Respiratory Diseases / Pulmonary Medicine) qualification against increased intake from 01(One) to 02(Two) seat(s) in respect of students being trained at Dr. Shankarrao Chavan Govt. Medical College, Nanded.

Sir,

It is stated that the assessment report (May, 2013) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Dr. Shankarrao Chavan Govt. Medical College, Nanded for purpose of Recognition of MD(Tuberculosis & Respiratory Diseases / Pulmonary Medicine) qualification against increased intake from 01(One) to 02(Two) seat(s) granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik was considered by the Board of Governors at its meeting held on 03.09.2013 and it was decided as under:-

"The Board of Governors considered the assessment report (May, 2013) and noted that MD(Tuberculosis & Respiratory Diseases / Pulmonary Medicine) qualification is already recognized with 01(One) seat(s) and decided to recommend that MD(Tuberculosis & Respiratory Diseases / Pulmonary Medicine) qualification against increased intake from 01(One) to 02(Two) seat(s) granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of students being trained at Dr. Shankarrao Chavan Govt. Medical College, Nanded be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 with the number of admissions to 02(Two) student(s) per year."

The Board of Governors further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21st July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

- 6.4. The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
- 6.6. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause-4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course.
