Sub: Recognition of MS(Orthopaedics) course at Dr. Shankarrao Chavan Government Medical College, Nanded under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Sir,

With reference to above, it is stated that the Postgraduate Committee appointed by the Board of Governors considered the compliance verification assessment report (February, 2011) along with Council Inspector's report (July, 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Government Medical College, Nanded now known as Dr. Shankarrao Chavan Government Medical College, Nanded for recognition of MS(Orthopaedics) course earlier under SRTM Marathwara University now Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee appointed by the Board of Governors considered the compliance verification assessment report (February, 2011) along with Council Inspector's report (July, 2009) and decided to recommend that MS(Orthopaedics) qualification earlier granted by SRTM Marathwara University now Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of students being trained at Government Medical College, Nanded now known as Dr. Shankarrao Chavan Government Medical College, Nanded be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admissions to 1(One) student per year.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21<sup>st</sup> July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

- 6.4 The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
- 6.6 Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause-4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course.

You are requested to notify the above qualification at the earliest.
